How to Read a Min/Max Thermometer



The Min/Max thermometer has a digital readout and a wire probe that is long enough to remain permanently inserted in the fridge. The probe should be attached to a water bottle or Glycol solution or inside an empty vaccine box. The digital readout should be in an easy to read location (not in the fridge). Temperatures are checked twice a day.

- 1. Ensure that the In/Out switch is set to "Out". This will give you the reading of the air from inside the fridge.
- 2. Record the current temperature.
- 3. Press the Min/Max button once to record the Min temperature. Once the temperature is read press clear.
- 4. Press the Min/Max button again and record the Max temperature. Once the temperature is read press clear.
