Primary Health Care (Central Zone) is offering training & education on group medical visits (GMVs).

What are Group Medical Visits?

GMVs offer a new and time-efficient way to support patients with similar chronic conditions. During these expanded appointments, patients receive care, education and advice within a supportive group environment. Overall, the time required by providers is similar, but the time for patients is greatly enhanced through longer contact with care providers and peers with relatable health needs. GMVs are led by 2 co-facilitators. At least 1 should have specific training in group facilitation.

GMVs can be offered in many combinations, including:

- Physician and interdisciplinary health care provider (facilitator)
- Two or more interdisciplinary health care provider
