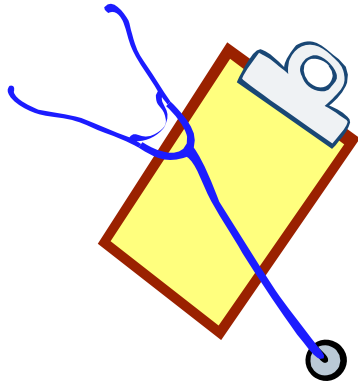


OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH



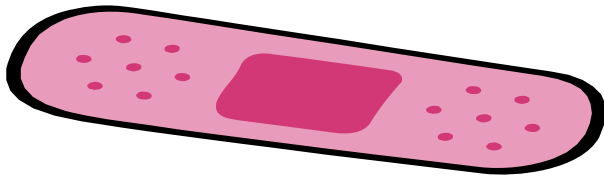
Occupational Health at Capital Health is available to administer care for work-related illness-injury sustained at the complex Monday – Friday (8 am – 4pm).

If you have an exposure to blood and/or body fluids immediate follow-up is needed. Refer to poster “Exposure to Blood and/or Body Fluids Requires Immediate Action”

All other health care needs should be arranged through your family doctor.

If you must be absent from the complex for any reason, please contact the departmental supervisor, delegate and/or instructor.
