The leap from data collection to analysis includes entering and organizing data. This workshop will introduce methods to ensure an organized data set that is easy to navigate. We will enter and import data together and take the initial steps for setting up a data set for analysis. Note: This session will not cover statistical methodology. Attendees are expected to be able to understand the methods behind the analyses offered or plan to attend the next session covering an Introduction to Statistics (see below), and will focus solely on use of SPSS.
