Subject: Revised Transfusion Medicine requisition and product issue request form

The Transfusion Medicine requisition CD001 and product issue request form have been updated. The revisions on the requisition include:

- Change from Blood Transfusion Services to Transfusion Medicine.
- Removal of CMV as a special requirement.
- Type and screen changed to ABORh, type and screen.
- Date of birth added to the collection declaration.

Product issue request form revisions include:

- Additional indications for transfusion of blood and blood components according to the provincial guidelines.
- Fibrinogen, activated factor VII and prothrombin complex have also been added to the form.
