Message: HS-Troponin T testing requires collection of separate collection container

Effective *May 18, 2021*, collection requirements for HS-Troponin T testing will be changed to a <u>separate</u> lithium heparin plasma-separator (light green) collection container at the QEII sites.

This practice will align the QEII with sample collection requirements already in place in the rest of Central Zone. Utilization of a separate collection container for troponin testing will improve the turnaround time of this test.

If a separate collection container is not received for HS-Troponin T testing, this may also delay the turnaround time for other tests linked to the shared tube.
