RE: Cancelling STAT Lab Testing and Ordering Priority

.....

To ensure timely and consistent notification of cancellation of STAT laboratory tests, the ordering unit will be notified by phone and a report will be expedited to the appropriate printer.

As a reminder, please ensure the appropriate priority is assigned to requests for laboratory testing. In general the following outlines expected turn-around time for test results.

• **STAT** results available within one hour from time of collection.

STAT is intended for life-threatening situations where results are required for the provision of immediate and safe patient care

- **Urgent** results available within 3 hours.
 - Urgent requests are prioritized ahead of routine, but after STAT. Patients whose discharge from hospital is dependent upon a laboratory test result should have the test ordered as **Urgent.**
- **Routine** result available within 8 hours.
