Please be advised that as of September 6, 2016 carbamazepine-10, 11 epoxide testing will now be referred to In-Common Laboratory (ICL) in Ontario due to low number of tests requested.

Note: The collection requirements remain the same but the required sample volume has increased to 2 mLs of serum.

All labs outside of NSHA Central Zone are kindly requested to refer these tests directly to ICL.
