Message: Changes to Barbiturate Testing in Urine Drug Screening

Effective January 11, 2016, the Nova Scotia Health Authority (NSHA)-Central Zone Division of Clinical Chemistry will discontinue barbiturate testing in our Drugs of Abuse (DoA), urine drug screening panel.

Barbiturate testing for NSHA Central Zone will be referred to Hospitals In-Common Laboratory (HICL) in Ontario upon approval by our Clinical Chemistry Medical Staff. All laboratories outside NSHA Central Zone are requested to refer samples directly to HICL. The cost of testing at HICL is \$16.00 per test.
