Subject:	Fat Pad Biopsy for Amyloid

When a fat pad biopsy is performed to investigate for amyloid, it is recommended NOT to perform a fine needle aspiration biopsy, since the yield is very low. Instead it is recommended that:

1. The procedure only be performed if there is a high index of suspicion

2. Several large core needle biopsies be taken, placed in formalin, and submitted to the Anatomical Pathology Laboratory

3. The requisition state FOR AMYLOID INVESTIGATION
