Update Regarding Repeat Rules

In order to ensure appropriate utilization of laboratory services, the Division of Clinical Chemistry, Department of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine at Capital Health has recently implemented repeat testing rules for the tests listed below. Understanding that there may be circumstances where testing is clinically warranted within the proposed repeat timelines, clinicians are reminded to indicate they do not want testing cancelled on the ordering requisition. Please be advised that the specific test(s) must be identified on the requisition. Any requests that simply state 'Do Not Cancel' without identifying the specific tests will not be considered.
