

EMERGENCY VOICE CODES

CODE	INCIDENT
Code Blue	Cardiac Arrest Will identify the need for a Cardiac Arrest response *Also used to identify the need for a response to a Medical Emergency at facilities outside the QEII.
Code Red	Fire Will signify a fire or fire alert situation. Enact your Fire Procedures.
Code Green Precautionary	Evacuation (Precautionary) Will indicate the need to evacuate able-bodied patients and visitors as a precautionary measure.
Code Green Stat	Evacuation (Crisis) Will indicate the need to immediately evacuate an area due to severe time limitations.
Code Orange Medical/Surgical	External Disaster Will indicate the activation of the Mass Casualties Protocol.
Code Yellow	Missing Patient Will notify staff that a patient is missing. Search your area.
Code White	Violent Person Will notify staff of the location of a violent person and situation.
Code Black	Bomb Threat Will notify staff of a general bomb threat. Initiate a search of your area. Notify security if you find a suspicious package.
Code Brown	Hazardous Substance Spill Will notify staff of the location of a hazardous materials spill or release.
Code Gray	External Air Exclusion Will notify staff to eliminate all sources of external air into the facility. The code is used to prevent hazardous substances from entering the building. Close all doors and windows to rooms and hallways.
Code Pink	Pediatric Medical Emergency Will alert staff to a pediatric medical emergency.

QEII (all buildings), DGH, NSH (all buildings) **Dial 473-3333** to report all emergencies. All other sites, Dial "0" to report all emergencies.
