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## **Contact Precautions**

- Hand Hygiene
- Private room or cohort (contact IPAC first).



- Staff PPE gloves required. Gown (based on risk assessment) if contact with patient or environment likely.
- Dedicate equipment or clean and disinfect b/w use.

## **Droplet Precautions**

Hand Hygiene



- Private room or 2 meter separation with privacy curtain pulled.
- Staff PPE surgical/procedure mask and eye protection.
- Patient surgical/procedure mask outside room.
- Dedicate equipment or clean and disinfect b/w use.

## **Airborne Precautions**

Hand Hygiene



- Negative pressure airborne infection isolation room with door closed.
- Staff PPE N95 respirator on entry\* for those not immune
- \*For chicken pox, disseminated zoster, and measles only immune staff should enter.
- Patient surgical/procedure mask outside room.
- Dedicate equipment or clean and disinfect b/w use.
